



This seed mix will bring beautiful wildlife into your garden. It can be planted in a location that gets sun most or all of the day. It contains both annual and perennial flowers. The perennial flowers will grow again for many years. This mixture of seeds is designed to provide color all season long that will attract winged friends to your yard.

One of the best things about wildflowers is how easy they are to grow!

How to plant your seeds in a garden.

Plan

- Check for your last frost date and plant after this has passed.
- Choose a spot on your property that gets 6 or more hours of direct sun a day.
- Prepare your soil by clearing the area of all existing growth. Simply dig up everything that is growing, turn the soil and rake the area flat. If this is an area that has never before been gardened, you may need to till the area up to remove growth.

Plant

- Mix the seeds with sand for better visibility and scatter the seeds directly on top of the soil.
- We recommend lightly patting the seeds into the soil, making sure not to bury them.

Grow

- Water so that the soil is moist, not soaking wet, until the seedlings are about 4-6" tall. After that, the seedlings will survive on natural rains. If you are experiencing very dry weather, we recommend watering occasionally.

How to plant your seeds in a pot.

- 1 Lay a loose layer of pottery shards or small rocks in the bottom of the pot to prevent soil from falling through the holes when the plant is watered.
- 2 Add potting soil, compost or both, a little bit at a time, pressing down on the soil as you work to eliminate air pockets. When the pot is full, arrange the seeds in the pot allowing plenty of space for growth. Leave 1 inch between the top of the soil and the edge of the pot to act as a reservoir when watering and to prevent water from overflowing the edge.
